08 DAYS BEST OF NEPAL



Highlights: Kathmandu City • Visit to 4 UNESCO World Heritage Sites • Chitwan • Jungle Activities • Pokhara Town • Sunrise Excursion • Boating

Book Nepal holidays to explore its best. As it says, this tour will take you to all major attractions in Nepal. These are the most famous destinations in Nepal that you would not want to miss. This tour starts from the cultural museum of the country Kathmandu. Then you will drive to the “Heart of the Jungle” Chitwan for the finest wildlife experience in Asia.

The tour proceeds to one of the country most famous hot spot Pokhara where you will enjoy the mild climate, tranquil lake and Himalayan peaks filling the skyline.



DAY 01: ARRIVAL – KATHMANDU (-/-/-)

Arrive in Kathmandu. Meeting and assistance at the airport and transfer to the hotel.
Rest of the day is free.
Overnight at the hotel in Kathmandu

DAY 02: KATHMANDU (BREAKFAST/-/-)

Morning, sightseeing tour of **Kathmandu Durbar Square and Swoyambhunath Stupa**

It is a place where the city's Kings were crowned. Having been built and rebuilt over the generations, it is now the valley's number one tourist attractions. Most of the temples you see here are a mere three or four centuries old. The entire square was designated as a World Heritage Monument in 1979. The Durbar Square is teeming with shrines and statues. Walk around Kumari Chowk which is a home of "living goddesses", she comes to the balcony at the scheduled time to welcome the guests.



On the top of the hill west of Kathmandu value is one of the popular and instantly recognizable symbols of Nepal. It is also referred to as "Monkey Temple" by many tourists because of the large tribes of monkeys that guards the hill. Legends say after the Bodhisattva Manjushri drained the water from the lake revealing the Kathmandu valley, the lotus on the island of the lake was transformed into the hillock, and the blazing light from the lotus became the statue.



Afternoon, tour of **Patan Durbar Square**

Patan also known as Lalitpur is the second largest city inside the valley. Patan has a long Buddhist influence and the four corners of the city are marked by Stupas said to have been created by great Buddhist emperor around 250 BC. Durbar Square forms the heart of Patan. The Durbar Square is closely packed with temples, and with far more concentration of architecture than anywhere around the valley.

DAY 03: KATHMANDU – CHITWAN (185 KMS/5 HRS) (BREAKFAST/LUNCH/DINNER)

After breakfast, drive to **Chitwan** through a scenic mountainous highway.

Chitwan is among Asia's finest national park, renowned for its variety and abundance of wildlife, and its top class tourist lodges and Jungle activities. You have to be extremely lucky to see one of its elusive tigers and leopards. However, an elephant safari is unforgettable and you are almost certain to see one horned rhino, various species of deer, monkeys and numerous species of birds. Stalking the animals, whether by elephant, dugout canoe, jeep or foot is the main activity here. Chitwan's big appeal is a pervasive sense of relaxation, which soaks deeper the longer you stay.



Upon arrival, transfer to the jungle resort.

After lunch, commence an elephant back safari to explore the jungle and view various wildlife.

Dinner and overnight at the jungle resort in Chitwan

DAY 04: CHITWAN (BREAKFAST/LUNCH/DINNER)

Indulge yourself in various jungle activities such as jungle walks, dugout/canoe ride, visit to Elephant breeding center, visit to local Tharu tribe villages e.t.c.

Evening flora and fauna presentation at the resort or live cultural dance performance by local Tharu tribes.

DAY 05: CHITWAN – POKHARA (165 KMS/5 HRS) (BREAKFAST/-/-)

After breakfast, drive to **Pokhara town**

Pokhara is the most popular destination in Nepal. It is also referred as city of lakes and mountains. It is also the gateway to one of the best trekking location in the world. Approx. 200 kms from Kathmandu Pokhara enjoys a mild climate, clean air, reflection of snowcapped mountains on the sheltered lake. Its relaxed atmosphere is pleasantly removed from the hectic hustle and bustle of Kathmandu. Lakeside Pokhara is a traveler’s oasis.



Upon arrival in Pokhara transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day is free. Evening, stroll around the lakeside area.

Overnight at the hotel in Pokhara.

DAY 06: POKHARA (BREAKFAST/-/-)

Early morning, excursion to **Sarangkot hill** for sunrise view and closer view of mountains.

At an elevation of 1592m, Sarangkot is probably the most popular short excursion from Pokhara. It is perfect viewpoint to admire the mountain views and splendid panorama. The panoramic view includes a glimpse of Mt. Dhaulagiri, Mt. Annapurna South and Mt. Hiunchuli with the bulk of Mt. Annapurna behind, unmistakable mt. Fishtail, Mt. Annapurna III, IV and II and Lamjung Himal. Pre-dawn excursion to Sarangkot is recommended to view beautiful sunrise over the Himalayas.



Afternoon, sightseeing tour of Pokhara town including Davi’s fall, Seti gorge, Gupteshwor Cave, Barahi temple etc. Later, one hour boating on Phewa lake.

Overnight at the hotel in Pokhara.



DAY 07: POKHARA – KATHMANDU (BREAKFAST/-/-)

After breakfast, drive back to Kathmandu retracing the same highway.

Upon arrival in Kathmandu, transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day is free for personal activities, shopping etc;

DAY 08: KATHMANDU – DEPARTURE (BREAKFAST/-/-)

Free till departure. Transfer to the airport in time to connect your onward flight.
